**GETTING STARTED** *“In your opinion...”*

1. In Sunday’s sermon we looked at learning to identify when God is working. If you can remember... was there anything helpful or questionable about this message?
2. How frequent is God doing His work?
3. What makes it *difficult* to recognize when God is at work?
4. What are the *benefits* of recognizing God’s work in tough times?
5. Have you been able to identify God at work in the midst of our nation’s unusual times?

**GOING DEEPER** *“According to the Bible...”*

*Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading*

- **Read 2 Kings 7:1-11.** This story begins in chapter 6 where Samaria is sieged by the Arameans. What was Elisha’s prophecy of God’s deliverance in chapter 7? How did the four lepers help all of Samaria? What lessons can we take in our current “quarantine”?
- **Read Philippians 1:12-26.** In the midst of his imprisonment, in what did Paul find joy? Did Paul ever complain about his circumstances? Why or why not? What was his view of death?
- **Read Philippians 4:10-13.** In what did Paul rejoice from this passage? Is it really possible to be content in any circumstance? Explain. What was Paul’s secret?
- **Read Matthew 24:1-31.** What are some specific signs Jesus said would happen before he returns? What is the “*abomination of desolation*”? According to verse 29-31, will Jesus return *before* these events or *after*?
- **Read Matthew 24:32-36.** What is the difference between a “*season*” and a “*day*”? What are we supposed to know and what are we unable to know about the timing of Jesus’ return?
