GETTING STARTED *“In your opinion...”*

1. Sunday’s sermon focused on how Jesus prepared his Disciples to overcome fear and live by faith when He walked on the water. Was there anything helpful, alarming, or questionable?
2. Have you ever had an experience where you felt like you were *“walking on water”*, i.e. with God’s help you were doing something you would you should not be able to do? Explain.
3. Has there ever been a time where you felt or believe God invited you to do something that seemed fearful, but you did it anyway? What happened?
4. Have you ever turned down God’s invitation to do something? What happened as a result?

GOING DEEPER *“According to the Bible...”*

Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading

- **Read Matthew 14:28-31.** Why do you think Peter asked Jesus to command him to walk on the water? Why do you think Peter looked at the waves while walking on water? At whom was he not looking when he looked at the waves? How might this apply to us if we are taking steps of faith?
- **Read Isaiah 41:10.** Is *“fear not”* easy or difficult? Explain. What does God promise so we do not have to be fearful or be anxious?
- **Read 1 John 4:18.** Whose love is being described here? How does being convinced of this love *“drive out”* fear? What does it mean to be made *“perfect in love”*?
- **Read Romans 8:14-17.** What relationship frees us from slavery to fear? How does this free us? Explain.
- **Read 2 Kings 6:8-18, *The Story of Elisha and Chariots of Fire.*** What did Elisha pray for his servant to calm his fear? How can this be applicable to us today?
