

GETTING STARTED *“In your opinion...”*

1. We are working through a three part message on Growing Up. Sunday’s message focused on spiritual maturity builds on Fundamentals, a solid Foundation. Was there anything from the sermon that was helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
2. The fundamentals are the same as a foundation laid for constructing a building. What does a foundation determine for a structure? What problems can occur if a foundation is weak or poorly built?
3. Of the six foundational qualities (*Repentance, Faith, Baptisms, Gifts, Resurrection, and Judgment Day*) what can be easily taken for granted or ignored? What can happen if we ignore them?
4. The first part of Spiritual maturity requires **Training**. This second part requires **Building** on a foundation. What are the differences between training and building?

GOING DEEPER *“According to the Bible...”*

Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading

- **Read Luke 6:46-49. What does the word “deep” represent in our life? What does the “rock” represent in our life? How do we dig down deep in our life to lay a solid foundation?**
- **Read Luke 14:25-30. In the context of being a disciple of Jesus, what could “building a tower” represent? What two priorities stated in verses 26 and 27 could be considered the foundation for the tower?**
- **Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15. What is the foundation of any Christian work? How important is the spiritual quality of the work we build on this foundation? What might be the difference between a work that burns up and a work that isn’t destroyed?**

LIVING OUT

- **A strong Foundation and a Work that endures are what Jesus is calling us to do. What work are you building?**
