GOING DEEPER *“According to the Bible...”*

Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading

- **Read John 14:21. What are the two steps we can do to get Jesus to show, reveal, or make Himself known to us?**
- **Read 1 Corinthians 11:1. In what way (“as”) does Paul tell the Corinthian church to imitate him? How should we be careful about imitating Christians we know?**
- **Read Hebrews 2:14, 15. What is the power of the devil? What did it take to break the power of the devil? How did this happen?**
- **Read James 4:7. What does it take to get rid of the devil?**
- **Read Ephesians 6:10, 11. What is required to stand against or resist the devil?**
- **Read Ephesians 6:13-17. What are the specific elements of this armor?**
- **Read Ephesians 6:18. After we armor up, what is the one action step we are directed to do in battling the devil?**
- **Read Galatians 2:20. How does this activity of dealing with the ego (“I”) help us in our battle with the devil?**
