GETTING STARTED *“In your opinion...”*

3. Why do you think the Jews in Jesus day essentially “skipped over” or ignored the prophecies about Messiah dealing with the sin problem?
4. Do you think this might still be a problem for people today?

GOING DEEPER *“According to the Bible...”*

Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading

Read the following verses and discuss if the New Testament passage affirms Jesus fulfilling the Old Testament prophecy?

- **Messiah a Prophet:** Deuteronomy 18:15-18 → Acts 3:17-26
- **Messiah a Priest:** Psalm 110:4 → Hebrews 5:4-10
- **Messiah a King:** 2 Sam 7:15; Jeremiah 23:5, 6 → Luke 1:26-33
- **Read Daniel 9:24-27.** In verse 27, what is “*signed*” (confirmed) and what is “*set up*” as indicators that the world is experiencing the last ‘*seven*’. At what point during the last ‘*seven*’ does the second event occur?
- **This “*abomination that causes desolation*” is mentioned four other times in the Bible.** What are some things that happen before and after it according to these passages?
 - **Daniel 11:31**
 - **Daniel 12:11**
 - **Matthew 24:15**
 - **Mark 13:14**
- **Read 2 Thessalonians 2:4.** What is “*set up*” in the temple? Could this be an “*abomination that causes desolation*”?
