**GETTING STARTED** *“In your opinion...”*

1. Sunday’s sermon examined how the healing of the blind man could help us restore our spiritual vision. Was there anything helpful or confusing about this message?
2. What does it mean to you to have spiritual vision?
3. One of the major points of the sermon was “***Becoming Like Jesus.***” In what ways do we become like Jesus and yet remain unique individuals?
4. The sermon mentioned three ***visions*** that God wants for our life. Can you think of anything else? What are some things that might distract us from seeing God’s vision for our life?
5. Have you ever had a sense of God’s vision for your life? Can you share that?

**GOING DEEPER** *“According to the Bible...”*

*Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading*

- **Read Numbers 22:21-31. Who saw *what* first and how did that affect them? Who enabled them to see? How might this help us understand how to see God’s vision for our life?**
- **Read 2 Corinthians 5:6-9. In verse 7 it says “*we walk by faith, not by sight.*” Considering the surrounding verses, what did Paul mean? How does that affect how we live?**
- **Read 2 Corinthians 4:4 and Revelation 3:17. What does it mean to be spiritually “*blind*” and what might cause it?**
- **Read Proverbs 29:18 in the KJV or NASB. What happens when people have *no vision* (or revelation)? Why?**
- **Read Habakkuk 2:2 in the KJV or NASB. What should do when we see or receive a “*vision*”? Why?**
- **Read Acts 13:36 in a version that uses the word “*purpose.*” As with David, do you think God has a unique purpose or vision for each of us? How can we discover that?**

- **Are you willing to ask God to show you His unique vision for you and your life?**
