GOING DEEPER "According to the Bible..."

Answer the following questions from what the Bible says in the suggested reading.

- Read Ecclesiastes 7:8. What makes "the end of a matter" "better", or more important, than "its beginning"? How does the way one finishes (or not finish) expose the reason for their involvement?
- Read 1 Corinthians 9:24-27. To what does Paul compare life's journey? What does Paul do to finish well?
- Read 2 Corinthians 11:23-29. Did Paul have any possible reasons to quit serving Christ? Explain.
- Read Philippians 3:7-14. What were Paul's strategies for finishing well? What role did Jesus play in His journey?
- Read Luke 8:4-15. What keeps the seed of God's word from taking root and bearing fruit? Which "soil" might best describe your life? Which one would you like to describe your life? What needs to be adjusted?
